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Lesson Plan for Advanced Students

This plan is to serve as a general guideline for students with a proficient knowledge of the French language – students falling in the **B2-C2** spectrum of the **Common European Framework (CEF)**, used internationally to assess and describe the level of fluency achieved by a foreign language learner.

These students can understand the main ideas of complex text on both concrete and abstract topics and can interact with ease with native speakers, expressing himself/herself fluently and spontaneously without strain. They can summarize information from various spoken and written sources and the most advanced students can use language flexibly and effectively for social, academic, and professional purposes.

Though grammar concepts are explored, unless the student has specific needs, these lessons tend to be fluid in structure and tend to focus on conversation, reading comprehension and exploration of more complex or specific topics.

This plan is designed **to further the student's knowledge of the language and maintain their mastery.** Since mastering a language is a continuing process, there is no limit on the number of lessons. Materials, homework, and email support is provided.
