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Lesson Plan for Intermediate Students

This plan is to serve as a general guideline for students with a basic working knowledge of the French language – students falling in the **A2-B2** spectrum of the **Common European Framework (CEF)**, used internationally to assess and describe the level of fluency achieved by a foreign language learner.

These students can understand sentences and communicate in simple and routine tasks, can describe experiences and events, and the more advanced among them can interact with a certain degree of fluency and spontaneity with native speakers without strain for either party.

This plan is designed **to improve their listening/speaking and reading/writing level** while reinforcing previously acquired skills. These lessons rely more heavily on grammar study.
